Orange County Association of Towns, Villages, & Cities: The July meeting will be held at the Park Restaurant in Highland Falls on July 31st, 2007,

Orange County Industrial Development Agency: Teresa Pierce, Town Clerk, submitted a memo to the board regarding a phone call she received from Bill Trimble of the Orange County IDA. He asked for use of our Town Hall Meeting room on the morning of Monday, August 20, 2007. According to Mr. Trimble, IDA regulations require 30 days notice to the paper prior to the date of a hearing, which is why approval is being sought this evening rather than at the August 2nd meeting. The hearing is in conjunction with the application from Medline Industries, Inc., a company that is proposing a distribution center which will be located in Wawayanda.

MOTION by **Deputy Supervisor Cole**, seconded by **Councilman Krajewski**, to authorize the Orange County Industrial Development Agency to use the Town Hall on August 20, 2007 to hold a Public Hearing for Medline Industries.
